



PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR

Minimum Qualifications:

Applicants must meet our minimum requirement including the following education, work experience, physical/health, and security requirements.

Must have:

Active duty or retired LEO ID with CCW / HR 218 privileges

Possession of a Peace Officers Standards and Training certificate (P.O.S.T.), or equivalent. Minimum of five (5) years of investigation experience

Valid state drivers' license and good driving record

California BSIS Guard Card (we will help you obtain/ active duty can work once paperwork is submitted)

California BSIS Firearms Permit (Preferred but optional, certain assignments may require)

Education/Work Experience: Applicants shall possess a high school education or equivalency, and documentary evidence of proficiency in firearms. All applicants hired need to be able to successfully qualify and maintain standards set forth by both the State of California and the Company.

Applicants must be United States Citizens.

Applicants will submit to Live Scan Fingerprinting and a complete background check, which will include driving record, Federal, State, or Local court records, credit, workers compensation record, education, credentials, identity, past addresses, social security number, employment and personal references which may include personal interviews with your current and past employers, friends and associates.

In addition to meeting the above requirements, applicants must pass a personal interview and a company range qualification.

Candidates need to possess a working knowledge of Federal, State and Local statutes, Private Investigator Act, ordinances, regulations and possess a working knowledge of the criminal justice judicial system.

Basic computer skills (MS Office, Internet searches, etc)

Physical and Health Requirements: All contract and permanent employees shall be in good physical condition and capable of carrying out the rigorous demands of investigative work. Must be able to sit, stand, walk and run for extended periods and must not have any physical or mental limitations, which would preclude them from performing their duties.

Ideal candidates will have prior investigative experience including surveillance, narcotics and witness interviewing. Must be able to work independently or as part of a team.
